On the occasion of the 40th anniversary of the worldwide leading architectural practice Herzog de Meuron, we are publishing the first three volumes of the complete works as an accessible paperback edition. The reprints in original format comprehensively present all buildings and designs from its beginnings in 1978 up to the year 1996. The development of the practice over the first two decades can be tracked in fascinating documents of the time, from the completion of local projects like the Blue House and Ricola Storage Building to world famous icons such as the Tate Modern and the Dominus Winery.

in the aoyama district of tokyo a mixed use neighborhood of low rise buildings where not a square meter of land has been left unoccupied the swiss architecture team of herzog de meuron has built a new store for prada in this chunky silvery book they meticulously illustrate the creative process that led to the realization of a house and a plaza a tall and narrow kaleidoscope like structure that houses a two story retail space and multiple levels of offices backed by an outdoor space for the public a rarity in crowded tokyo the finished structure encased in a visually porous shell or skin is as decorative as it is architectural or as architectural as it is decorative and is both metaphorically and literally linked to its surrounding environment and to the idea of the garment here is the story of a theoretically and structurally complex building told lovingly and simply by its architects through words models sketches photographs and architectural renderings

between 1996 and 2000 the renowned architects herzog de meuron built a new research centre together with a library auditorium and cafeteria for the pharmaceutical company roche in basle situated on the outskirts of the town on the edge of the industrial area the building was to include a closed section for laboratories yet should also be publicly accessible the ideal starting point for an interdisciplinary solution artist rémy zaugg worked together with the architects developing the colours used in particular he created a dramatic blue wall which separates public and restricted areas this publication documents the entire project from its genesis to the completed construction using texts sketches plans and photographs more than a mere monograph this book provides a fascinating glimpse into the creative collaboration occurring between architects and artists
